

SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 22 S. R. 12 W. W.M.

CHAINS	
	S.89*51'W., on a true line, bet. Secs. 13 and 24. Over broken N. slope through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
11.06	Bottom land, and clearing of C. Christopherson, bears N E., S W., 160 ft. below closing corner. Thence over fine rich land of homestead.
12.27	Dry bed of stream, 4 lks. wide, course N.
14.27	Christopherson's house bears S. 35 lks. dist.
19.27	Leave bottom and clearing, bears S.30*E., N.30*W. From this point, Schofield River bears N.50 lks. dist. Ascend steep N E slope through dense undergrowth and timber.
29.25	Spur, 200 ft. high, slopes N. Descend along general W. slope.
36.50	Henry Winter's house and improvements, bears N.31*30'W., 30 chs. dist.
41.48	Set a Chitten post, 3 ft. long, 9 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 on N., and 24 on S face: from which An Alder, 28 ins. diam., bears N.10*45'E., 12 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T. An Alder, 30 ins. diam., bears S.31*45'E., 88 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 B T.
44.00	Bottom land, 700 ft. below beginning of descent, bears N and S. Thence over good rich bottom land.
45.33	Cow trail, bears N. and S.
46.22	Creek, 4 lks. wide, course N. Leave bottom land and ascend E. slope.
50.73	Branch, 1 lk. wide, course N E.
57.77	Ridge, 700 ft. high, bears N and S. Descend W. slope.
67.19	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N W., 650 ft. below ridge. Thence over broken N. slope.
72.28	Branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.
