Land, sandy.  
Soil, 3rd rate.

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West, on true line bet. secs. 12 and 13.

2.40 Stream 3 lks. wide, course NE.

6.50 Ridge, course N & S.

40.00 Set qr. sec. post, from which  
A spruce, 30 ins. diam., bears N.20\*E., 6 lks. dist.  
A spruce, 15 ins. diam., bears S.40\*W., 27 lks. dist.

41.00 A beacon, bears N.83½\*W.  
Base, S. 6½\*W., 4.56 chs. beacon bears N.64\*W.,  
Angle, 19½\*. Distance, 13.05 chs.  
Hence the beacon is 1.53 chs. N. of line at 53.96.
