	Heavily timbered with fir and hemlock, 80.70 chs. Dense undergrowth of vine-maple and hemlock, 80.70 chs. Soil, sandy and rocky 2nd and 4th rate	
	Beginning at the cor. to secs. 34 and 35 on S boundary of Tp. thence N.2°W. between secs. 34 and 35 Va. 20°E	
10.00	Ascending through timber Top of ridge, course SE	+100
