28.25	Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S., on N. face, from which, A V. Maple, 6 ins. diam., bears N.56*E., 11 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B T. A Dogwood, 6 ins. diam., bears S.42*W., 41 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.	
31.85	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SW. Ascend.	- 50
42.25	Trail from Oakland to Bohemia mines bears NW. and SE.	
44.25	Top of ridge bears NW. and SE. Descend.	+250
