	Enter prairie, course N E. & S W.	
52.00	Leave prairie enter timber, course E & W.	
53.00	Top of mountain, course East & West. Steep descent 10.00 chs..	
80.00	Set post cor. to secs. 34, 35, 26 & 27 from which, A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.70°W., 30 lks. dist. A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.88°W., 13 lks. dist. A cedar, 9 ins. diam., bears N.4°E., 27 lks. dist. A yew, 5 ins. diam., bears S.88°E., 53 lks. dist. Mount Lama Scocum bears S.75°E. The first 4.00 chs. passes over good soil with some scattering timber. Remainder down rocky mountain side. Timber fir. Soil second rate.
