	Which gives for dist. across the river 9.63 chs. to which add 68.37 chs. dist. South of river making 78.00 chs. to right bank of river.
78.00	Where I set a post for cor. to fractional secs. 31 and 32 on the North side of river, from which, An ash, 8 ins. diam., bears S.60*W., 60 lks. dist. A broken maple, 36 ins. diam., bears S.48*E., 95 lks. dist.
79.00	Military road, course N.60*W.
80.00	Set post cor. to secs. 29, 30, 31 & 32, from which, A maple, 36 ins. diam., bears S.15*E., 274 lks. dist. An ash, 8 ins. diam., bears S.12½*W., 236 lks. dist. A willow, 6 ins. diam., bears N.87½*W., 297 lks. dist.
	No tree in sec. 29 convenient to mark, drove charred post 14 in. long, raised mound with trench as per instructions.
	The S E. cor. of Robertsons claim, bears N.60*W., 30 lks. dist. from the Meander Post on right bank of river between secs. 31 and 32.
	Land South of river broken. Soil 2nd rate. River rapid, and banks high. Timber fir and cedar.
	East on random line between secs. 29 and 32. Va. 19*30'E.
40.00	Set temporary ¼ sec. post.
80.85	Intersect North and South line at post cor. to secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33. From this cor. I run West on a true line between secs. 29 and 32 in prairie.
17.85	Road, course N W., & S E.
18.85	Enter J. J. Kellogg's Field.
40.42½	Set ¼ sec. post. Drove charred post 12 ins. long, raised mound as per instructions.
