40.00	Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. post.
80.60	Intersect North and South line, 40 lks. North of cor. to secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29 from this cor., I run N.89°43'W. on true line between secs. 20 and 29.
14.50	East fence of Cooper's pasture.
17.60	Southwest fence of Cooper's pasture.
28.60	Road to Cooper's & Dimick's ferry, and to Scottsburg, course N.20°W.
31.90	West boundary of James T. Cooper's claim.
40.30	Set $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. post, from which, A black oak, 12 ins. diam., bears S.55°W., 100 lks. dist. A black oak, 6 ins. diam., bears N.52°E., 53 lks. dist.
50.60	Widow Kellogg's house bears South.
67.40	N E. cor. of Thomas Robertson's claim.
80.60	Cor. to secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30. Land level. Timber of oak. Undergrowth of same. Soil 1st rate.
