40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
79.80	Intersect E. bdy. of r., 70 lks. North of cor. North 89°30' West on true line between secs. 25 & 36.
00.75	Creek 5 lks. wide, course N. Begin ascent.
8.00	Top of spur, course N.
39.90	Set fir post for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which, A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.20°E., 36 lks. A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears South, 9 lks.
51.00	Creek 2 lks. wide, course N.
79.80	To sec. cor. Land mountainous, 3rd rate. Heavily timbered chiefly fir, cedar, etc.
	North between secs. 25 & 26. va. 19°30'E.
10.00	Top of ridge, course NE.
35.00	Begin steep descent.
40.00	Set dogwood for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor, from which, A dogwood, 10 ins. diam., bears S.30°E., 30 lks. dist. A maple, 14 ins. diam., bears S.80°W., 54 lks. dist.
44.50	Creek 7 lks. wide, course N.30°E.
63.00	Steep descent.
72.00	Creek 25 lks. wide, course NW.
80.00	Set yew post for cor. to secs. 23, 24, 25 & 26, from which, A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.80°E., 67 lks. A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.35°E., 62 lks. A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.40°W., 62 lks. A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.60°W., 26 lks. Land mountainous, 2nd rate. Heavily timber chiefly fir, cedar & yew.
