Beginning at the witness cor. to secs. 23 & 24 which is 72.50 chs. north of cor. to secs. 23, 24, 25 & 26 and which I reestablish by setting a stone 18 x 14 x 4 ins., 15 ins. in the ground for witness cor. to secs. 23 & 24, from which,

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.55\*W., 23 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 23 W C B T.

The SE bearing tree being gone,

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.35\*E., 19 lks. dist., which I mark T 23 S R 8 W S 24 W C B T.

Thence I run N.0\*1'W between secs. 23 & 24.

Va. 20\*35'E at 3 P M April 21st.

Ascend through timber.

A point about 250 ft. above witness cor. set a stone 14 x 12 x 6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 13, 14, 23 & 24, with 3 notches on S and 1 notch on E edges, from which,

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.88\*E., 30 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 13 B T.

A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears S.21\*E., 48 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 24 B T.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.34\*W., 32 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 23 B T.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.82\*W., 16 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 14 B T.

Land mountainous 7.50 chs. Soil 3rd rate. Heavily timbered with fir, and maple with dense undergrowth of hazel and thimbleberry. 7.50 chs.
