A fir, 14 ins, diam., bears N.10*W., 60 lks. dist.,
marked T 23 S R 8 W S 23 B T.

Over N. slope through timber.

39.97 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.39*E., 35 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A dogwood, 6 ins. diam., bears N.41*E., 19 lks.
dist marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

55.00 Top of a ridge, course N. about 250 ft. above Sec. cor.
Descend.

72.60 Stream 2 lks. wide, course N W. about 250 ft. below
top of last ridge.

77.50 Stream 3 lks. wide, course N.

79.94 The cor. to secs. 22, 23, 26, & 27.
