

Subdivision of T. 23 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

CHAINS 75.00	Top of a spur, course S., about 150 ft high. Descend.
79.56	The cor. to secs. 14, 15, 22 & 23. Land mountainous. Soil 3rd rate. Heavily timbered with fir, and laurel. Dense undergrowth of hazel, sallow, fern and briars. 79.56 chs. April 26th, 1894.
6.75	N.0*2'W., between secs. 14 & 15. Va. 20*38'E., at 8 A M Apr. 27th. Ascend through timber.
26.00	A fir, 24 ins., diam., with 2 notches on N & S sides.
39.40	Top of a ridge, course S.60*W. Top of a mountain, course E & W., about 500 ft. above cor. and descend.
40.00	Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on West face from which A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.3*E., 88 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A maple, 10 ins. diam., bears N.1*W., 72 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
80.00	A point about 200 ft. below top of mountain. Set a post 4 ft. long, and 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground for cor. to sec. 10, 11, 14 & 15, marked T 23 S S 11 on N E. R 8 W S 14 on S E S 15 on S W and S 10 on N W faces with 5 notches on S and 2 notches on E edge from which A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.5*E., 45 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 11 B T. A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.30*E., 79 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 14 B T.
