

## Subdivisions of T. 23 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

CHAINS	
43.50	Top of mountain, course NE.
58.50	Stream 1 lk. wide, course NW.
73.00	Top of mountain, course NW. Thence descend over broken E slope.
80.00	Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 27, 28, 33, & 34 marked, T 23 S S 27 on NE. R 8 W S 34 on SE. S 33 on SW and S 28 on NW faces with 1 notch on S & 3 notches on E edge, from which, A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.56°E., 17 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 27 B T. A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.29°E., 21 lks. di st., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 34 B T. A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.52°W., 55 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 33 B T. No other tree convenient NW. A perpendicular rock marked with a cross (x) and S 28 B O., bears N.65°W., 43 lks. dist. Land mountainous. 80 chs. Soil 3rd & 4th rate. Heavily timbered with fir, cedar and hemlock. Dense under- growth of rhododendron, sallal, vine maple and mountain balm.
	East on a random line between secs. 27 & 34. va. 20°40'E.
40.00	Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.16	Intersect N & S line at cor. to secs. 26, 27, 34 & 35. Thence I run West on a true line between secs. 27 & 34. va. 20°38'E. Ascend over N slope through timber.
