80.00	<p>A point about 100 ft. above stream. Set a post 4 ft. long and 4 ins. sq., 2 ft. in ground for corner to secs. 3, 4, 9 & 10 marked T 23 S S 3 on NE. R 8 W S 10 on SE. S 9 on SW and S 4 on NW faces with 5 notches on S and 3 notches on E edges, from which, A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.58*E., 70 lks. dist., marked T. 23 S R 8 W S 3 B T. A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.16*E., 12 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 10 B T.</p>
