Descend.

33.50 Stream 2 lks. wide, course N.60*W., 400 ft. below Sec. cor.

Ascend gradually.

40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long and 3 ins. sq., 2 ft. in ground

for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W face. from which,

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N.76*E., 20 lks.

dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A fir, 8 ins. diam. bears S.23*W., 30 lks.

dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

Descend.

50.00 Enter creek bottom, course N E & S W. A point about

200 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

58.45 Hedden Creek, 12 lks. wide, course N E., and leave creek

bottom, course N E. and S W., and ascend through

timber.

78.44 Wagon road, course N.70*W. & S.70*E.

82.26 Intersect N boundary of township 60 lks. W., of cor. to

secs. 3 & 4. At which point I set a post 4 Ft. long,

4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor.

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears S.31*W., 138 lks.

dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 4 B T.

No tree in limits N. of line. Pit impracticable.

Land mountainous, 73.81 chs.; soil 3rd & 4th rate.

Remaining 8.45 chs. level bottom; soil 1st rate.

Heavily timbered with fir, cedar and hemlock. 82.26 chs.

Dense undergrowth of salmonberry, sallal, vine maple,

Arrowwood and briars 82.26 chs.
