

Subdivision of T. 23 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

CHAINS

- 50.50 Top of a ridge, course N & S., about 600 ft., above last stream. Descend gradually.
- 79.93 The corner to sec. 4, 5, 8 & 9.
Land mountainous 79.93. Soil 3rd & 4th rate. Heavily timbered with fir, cedar and hemlock. Dense undergrowth of hemlock, vine maple, hazel and briars.
-
- N.0*3'W., on a true line between Sec. 4 & 5.
Va. 20*30'E.
- Over East slope.
- 23.00 Top of mountain, course N E & S W., about 200 ft. above corner. Descend.
- 27.85 A fir, 60 ins. diam.
- 40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long and 3 ins. sq., 2 ft. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face, from which,
A maple, 8 ins. diam., bears S.15*E., 35 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears N.38*W., 28 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- 51.50 Stream 3 lks. wide, course N W., a point about 600 ft. below top of mountain, and ascend.
- 63.00 Top of spur, course W. 100 ft. high.
- 67.18 A fir, 30 ins. diam., marked with 2' notches on N & S. sides.
- 84.00 Intersect N. boundary of township 2.98 chs. E. of cor. to secs. 32 & 33. At which point I set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to secs. 4 & 5, marked C C T 23 S R 8 W on S., S 4 on E. and S 5 on W., with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W., sides, from which
A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.1*E., 7 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 4 B T.
A white fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.26*W., 28 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 5 B T.
