

Subdivision of T. 23 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

CHAINS

29.50 Leave same, course N. E., ascend over broken E. slope.

40.00 A point about 250 ft. above Belshazzar Creek. Set a post 3 ft. long 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face, from which,

A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 28 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A chittewood, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 47*E., 13 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

44.40 Top of ascent on E. slope and descend to,

67.40 Camp Creek, 25 lks. wide, course W. Ascend abruptly.

80.00 A point about 400 ft. above Camp Creek. Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 19, 20, 29 & 30, marked T 23 S S 20 on N E., R 8 W S 29 on S E., S 30 on S W., and S 19 on the N W. faces with 2 notches on S. and 5 notches on E. edges, from which,

A chinquapin, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 58*E., 22 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W 20 B T.

A chinquapin, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 74*E., 27 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 30 B T.

A laurel, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 73*W., 35 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 30 B T.

A chinquapin, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 53*W., 12 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 8 W S 19 B T.

Land mountainous 80 chs. Soil 3rd & 4th rate. Heavily timbered with fir, hemlock, cedar, chinquapin and laurel. Dense underbrush of salmonberry, hemlock, vine maple and briars.
