CHAINS 68.00	Ascend.
80.42	A point about 250 ft. above bench. The cor. to secs. 7, 8, 17 & 18.  Land mountainous 80.42 chs. Heavily timbered with fir, maple and cedar. Dense undergrowth of salmonberry, sallal, vine maple and briars.
	N.89°59'W., on a random line between secs. 7 & 18.  va. 20°30'E.
40.00	Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
96.72	Intersect W boundary of township 50 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 7 & 18. Thence, I run, S.89°41'E., on a true line between secs. 7 & 18.  va. 20°20'E.
	Ascend through timber.
13.20	Top of ridge, course NE & SW about 300 ft. above cor. and descend to
32.35	Stream 3 lks. wide, course SW about 250 ft. below and ascend.
56.72	A fir, 40 ins. diam., which I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N side for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which,  A maple, 14 ins. diam., bears N.25°E., 19 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.  A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.58°W., 30 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.  Continue to ascend.
78.70	Bottom of a little ravine, course S and ascend abruptly.
91.70	Summit of mountain, course N & S about 900 ft. above last stream and descend.
96.72	The cor. to secs. 7, 8, 17 & 18.  Land mountainous 96.72 chs. Soil 3rd & 4th rate. Heavily timbered with fir, hemlock, maple and cedar. Dense undergrowth of sallal, vine maple, briars and bramble bushes.
