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North Boundary of T. 24 S., R. 9 W., W.M.

- 16.00 A creek 12 lks. wide, course SW.
- 40.00 Set Fir post 40 ins. long, 5 ins. diam., in ground, 18 ins. for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. corner on North bdy. of Sec. 6, from which,  
A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.80\*E, 35 lks. dist.  
A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears South, 7 lks. dist.
- 62.00 Top of perpendicular bluff 200 ft.
- 63.50 Lake Creek, 100 lks. wide, course W.
- 68.00 Leave same, course NW., steep rocks
- 72.00 Point (72.00) Top of same
- 75.00 Foot of same
- 78.70 To Township corner.

Land terribly broken, rocky, 3rd rate  
Timber (poor) chiefly Fir.  
Underbrush, same as former line.

September 14th, 1878

This Township contains but a limited amount of first rate lands, viz. the valley of the main creek and a few of it's tributaries. The entire Township is covered with a dense forrest of timbers, chiefly Fir, Cedar, Hemlock, Maple, Ash, Laurel, Yew, Chincapin, Laurel and a few other varieties abound in various localities.

The underbrush is very dense and of same as above; Vine-Maple, Huckleberry, "Sallall", Hazel, Tasselwood, Crab-apple, Spice and Salmon brush.

This valley will support considerable of a settlement and a portion of it should therefore be subdivided.
