62.00 Enter open grassy marsh

71.00 Leave same, enter timber

76.00 Trail, course E. and W.

80.00 Set Chitem-wood post 36 x 5, 18 ins. in ground for corner to Secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, from which

A Fir, 60 ins, diam., bears N.25\*E., 62 lks. dist.

A Maple, 6 ins. diam., bears S.25\*E., 18 lks. dist.

A Maple, 14 ins. diam., bears S.75\*W., 14 lks. dist.

A Maple, 12 ins. diam., bears N.22\*W., 57 lks. dist.
