40.00 Set a vine-maple post, 3 ft long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins.  
in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S.36 on N.  
face, from which,

A Vinemaple, 5 ins. diam., bears N.27\*E. 32 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 36 B T.

A Hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S.41\*W. 47 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 36 B T.

41.53 Cor. of Secs. 1 and 2, which is a Fir post, 5 ins. sq.  
24 ins. high, marked and witnessed as described by the  
surveyor general; I destroyed all marks, referring to  
my tp.

A stream, 5 lks. wide, course NW., begin ascent of a  
NE. slope.

48.50 Top of a spur, bears N. and S., begin descent along a  
W. slope; covered heavily with Fir, Hemlock and Cedar.

79.30 A stream, 1 lk. wide, course N.

80.00 Set a Chinquapin post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins.  
in the ground for cor. of Secs. 35 and 36, marked  
T. 23 S., S 36 on NE., and R. 9 W., S35 on NW. faces  
with 1 notch on E. and 5 notches on W. edges, from  
which,

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.17\*W 39 lks. dist.  
marked T 23 S. R 9 W. S. 35 B T.

A Hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears N.10\*E. 39 lks. dist.  
marked T 23 S. R 9 W S 36 B T.

This cor. stands 175 ft. below top of spur.

Land, mountainous

Soil, 3rd rate; rocky.

Timber, Fir, Cedar, Spruce, Hemlock, Chinquapin.

Undergrowth, Salmonberries, Huckleberry, Vinemaple.
