CHAINS

Land, mountainous. Soil gravelly and 3rd rate.  
Timber, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock, Maple.  
Undergrowth, dense and of Huckleberries and Salmonberries.  
Mountainous and heavily timbered land and covered by  
dense undergrowth. 80.00 chains.

S.89\*35'W bet secs. 32 and 5.

Still descending mountain slope covered heavily with  
timber and dense undergrowth.

5.05 Old quarter section corner post being gone, I re-estab-  
lished the corner by setting a Fir post, 3 ft. long,  
3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, marked and witness-  
ed as described by the surveyor general.

Land, mountainous. Soil, gravelly and 3rd rate.

Timber, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock.

Underbrush, Huckleberry and Salmonberry.

Mountainous and heavily timbered land. 5.05 chains.

37.40 From my initial point of survey set by me Aug. 17, I  
run N.89\*35'E. on N. bdy. of sec. 1, T. 24 S. R. 9 W.  
Ascend mountain slope, covered heavily with timber.  
The cor. of sec. 1, T. 24 S., R. 9 W; which is a fir post,  
4 ins. sq., 24 ins. high, marked and witnessed as des-  
cribed by the surveyor general. 37.40 chs.  
Mountainous or heavily timbered land. Aug. 24, 1898.

Subdivisions of T. 23 S., R. 9 W., W.M.  
same Deputy and Contract.

I commence at the cor. of secs. 32 and 33 on the S. bdy.  
of the Tp. established by me August 19, thence I run  
N.0\*3'W. on true line bet. secs. 32 and 33, descending  
a N. slope of mountain covered with Fir and Cedar.

17.15 A stream, 4 lks. wide, course NW., 150 ft. below sec.  
cor. begin ascent of a S. slope of mountain covered  
(beside timber) with a dense undergrowth of huckle-  
berry, salal berries, vine-maple and poison laurel.

32.50 Top of a ridge, bears E. and W., 120 ft. above stream.  
Begin to descend.

40.00 Set a Fir post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the  
ground for 1/2 sec. cor., marked 1/2 S 32 on W. face,
