A Hemlock, 36 ins. diam., bears S.43*E., 58 lks. dist. marked T 23 S R 9 W S 14 B T.

A Hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears S.51*W., 31 lks. dist. marked T 23 S R 9 W S 15 B T.

A Chittewood, 6 ins. diam., bears N.72½*W, 21 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 9 W S 16 B T.

Land, mountainous

Soil, gravelly; 3 rd rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Chittewood.

Undergrowth, Huckleberries, Salmon berries.

Mountainous or heavily timbered land.
