CHAINS

W.D. Owen's Trail bears NE. and SW.

Descend along NW. slope of mountain.

63.00 A stream, 2 lks. wide, course NE., 200 ft below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., begin ascent of E. slope.

71.70 Top of spur, bears E. and W., 125 ft. above stream; begin steep descent of N. slope.

80.00 Set an alder post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23 marked, T 23 S S 14 on NE.; R 9 W S 23 on SE.; S 22 on SW. and S 15 on NW. faces, with 3 notches on S. and 2 notches on E. edges, from which

A Fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.66°E., 50 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 9 W S 14 B T.

A Fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S.72°E., 26 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 9 W S 23 B T.

A Maple, 6 ins. diam., bears S.77°W., 60 lks. dist. marked T 23 S R 9 W S 22 B T.

A Maple, 4 ins., diam., bears N.76°W., 13 lks. dist. marked T 23 S R 9 W S 15 B T

Land, mountainous

Soil, gravelly and 3 rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder.

Dense undergrowth of small firs, huckleberries, salmonberries.

Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth.

80.00 chs.

S.89°54'E. on a random line, bet. secs. 14 and 23.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

79.50 Intersect N. and S. line, 48 lks. S. of cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, thence I run,

S.89°45'W. on true line bet. secs. 14 and 23.
