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Subdivisions of T. 23 S., R. 9 W., W.M.

CHAINS  
40.00

A point, 450 ft. below top of ridge, set a hemlock post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 21 on W. face, 22 on E. face from which,

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.76\*E., 18 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 22 B T.

A Hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears N.16\*W., 26 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 21 B T.

Continue descending a NE. slope.

47.80 Foot of descent, 120 ft. below  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. enter bottom covered with a dense undergrowth of salmonberries and vinemaple.

49.40 N. fork of Soup Creek, 20 lks. wide, course W.,

53.85 A stream, 2 lks. wide, course SW., begin to ascend S. slope of mountain, heavily timbered.

67.50 Top of spur, bears SW. and NE. 200 ft. above creek, begin to descend W. slope.

80.00 A point, 150 ft. below spur, I set a hemlock post, the ground 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in  $\wedge$  for cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22, marked T 23 S 15 on NE.; R 9 W S 22 on SE.; S 21 on SW. and S 16 on NW. face and 3 notches on S. and E. edges, from which,

A Fir, 70 ins. diam., bears N.19\*E., 19 lks. dist. marked T 23 S R 9 W S 15 B T.

A hemlock, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E., 29 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 9 W S 22 B T.

An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears S.7\*W., 42 lks. dist. marked T 23 S R 9 W S 21 B T.

A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears N.3\*W., 50 lks., dist. marked T 23 S R 9 W S 16 B T.

Land, mountainous and level
