Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered
with dense undergrowth.

N.89°56'E. on a random line bet. secs. 15 and 22.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.10 Intersect N. and S. line, 20 lks. N. of cor. of secs.
14, 15, 22 and 23, thence I run

N.89°55'W. on a true line bet. secs. 15 and 22.

A steep descent of E. slope of mountain, covered
heavily with timber, and dense undergrowth.

4.85 Top of ridge, bears NW. and SE., begin descent.

17.20 A stream, 2 lks. wide, course NW., 200 ft. below ridge,
continue descent.

27.90 Top of spur, bears NW. and SE., continue descent.

38.85 A stream, 4 lks. wide, course NW., 150 ft. below top
of spur.

40.05 Set a hemlock post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in
the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 15 on N. face,
22 on S. face, from which

A cedar, 40 ins. diam., bears N.70°E., 15 lks. dist.
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 15 B T.

A hemlock, 20 ins. in diam., bears S.13°E., 51 lks.,
dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 22 B T.

Go along N. slope of mountain.

52.20 A stream, 2 lks. wide, course N., begin descent of NW.
slope of mountain.

80.10 The cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22.
