CHAINS

- 54.25 A creek, 30 lks. wide, course NE.
- 80.00 Set hemlock post, 4 ft. long, 5 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground for the corner to secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.
Post on high mountain, from which
A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.25*E., 31 lks. dist.
A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears S.50*E., 30 lks. dist.
A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.89*W., 27 lks. dist.
A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.55*W., 14 lks. dist.
Land, broken, mountainous, 3rd rate.
Timber, good, chiefly fir, hemlock and cedar.
Underbrush, same and huckleberry, vine maple, salmonberry etc.
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- East on random line between secs. 25 & 36.
Va. 20*E.
- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 80.80 Intersect 48 lks. North of corner.
North 89*39'West on true line between secs. 25 & 36.
- 10.00 Enter creek bottom, course N & S.
- 12.50 Open swale. Water 8 ins. deep, course N & S.
- 14.00 Across same.
- 26.25 Lake creek, 1.00 wide, course NW.
- 37.00 Begin ascent.
- 40.40 Set a hemlock post, 4 ft. long, 5 ins. diam., 18 ins. in ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. between secs. 25 & 36,
from which
A hemlock, 36 ins. diam., bears S.20*E., 12 lks. dist.
A hemlock, 30 ins. diam., bears N.20*W., 30 lks. dist.
- 62.00 A creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE.
- 80.80 To sec. corner.
Land in creek bottom 1st rate. Hills & mountains 2nd & 3rd rate.
