	<p>Cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22</p> <p>Thence I run</p> <p>N.0°1'W., bet. secs. 15 and 16.</p> <p>A cross steep W. slope of mountainous land through heavy timber and dense undergrowth:</p>
3.25	Bottom of gulch on mountainside, sloping W. 100 ft. below the sec. cor.
19.50	A gulch; course W.
27.50	Branch, 1 lk. wide; course SW.
28.00	Leave dense undergrowth and enter a burn covered with fallen trees; bears NE. and SW.
33.00	Re-enter dense undergrowth, bears SW. and NE.
35.00	A spring, bears West, 75 lks. dist.
39.00	Leave dense undergrowth, and enter burn covered with fallen trees and scattering green trees and brush, bears NW. and SE.

62.80	Branch, 2 lks. wide, 200 ft. below summit; course N.70*E.
