

Subdivisions of T. 23 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS

Undergrowth, small fir, hemlock, alder, arrowwood, salal, thimbleberry, salmonberry and vinemaple.

Land, mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth, 113.53 chs.

At the cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16.

Thence I run,

N.0°2'W., bet. secs. 9 and 10.

Descend along E. slope of mountainous land through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

14.50 Bottom of descent in head of gulch; 100 ft. below sec. cor., course E.

30.00 Bottom of gulch, 50 ft. deep, course E and ascend.

40.00 Intersect E end of a stone, 24x20x20 ins. above ground, Cut a + at exact place for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N face, (the W. face being inaccessible); from which
A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.15°E., 15 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 10 B T.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.4°W., 24 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 B T.

46.50 Enter burn on side of ridge, bears SW and NE.

51.00 Re-enter dense undergrowth, bears SW and NE on summit of main divide bet. Coos River and Loon Lake, 300 ft. above gulch.

Descend W side of ridge.

63.00 Branch, 1 lk. wide, 400 ft. below divide, course NW.

68.70 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course W.

80.00 Set a basalt stone 24x6x6 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, marked with 5 notches on S and 3 notches on E edge, from which

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.76°E., 124 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 10 W S 3 B T.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.86°E., 84 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 10 W S 10 B T.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.73°W., 81 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 10 W S 9 B T.
