A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.41*W., 150 lks. dist.,
marked T 23 S R 10 W S 4 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky; 3rd and 4th rate.

Timber, second growth fir.

Undergrowth, small fir, salal and huckleberry.

Land, mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with dense
undergrowth, 80.00 chs.

August 15, 1906.

At the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

Thence I run,

S.89*51'E., on a random line bet. secs. 3 and 10.

50.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.14 Intersect N and S line, 21 lks. S of cor. of secs. 2,
3, 10 and 11.

Thence I run,

West, on a true line bet. secs. 3 and 10.

Descend over rough mountainous land through green timber
and dense undergrowth.

10.74 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course S.

22.35 A creek, 5 lks. wide in rocky gorge, 200 ft. below sec.
cor., ascend.

40.07 Cut a + on face of sandstone bluff at exact point of
 $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.21*E., 14 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 10 B T.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.73*W., 28 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 B T.

40.25 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.20*E., over bare rock.

42.30 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course NE.

45.05 Same branch, course S.70*E.

60.00 Leave green timber and enter burn, covered with logs,
bears S.80*E and NW.
