

**Meanders of T. 23 S., R. 10 W.**

CHAINS

I commence at the meander cor. of frac. secs. 11 and 12,  
44.64 chs. N.0°34'W of cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14.

Thence I run with meanders in sec. 11.

N.75½°W	2.00 chs.	Across rocky debris at mouth of creek, no channel, in alder thicket at high water.
N.64°W	2.30	Along rough mountainside, 8 ft. above shore, in dense undergrowth.
S.64°W	3.70	At 3.20 chs. foot of rocky bluff.
N.49½°W	1.60	
N.74°W	2.50	
N.56°W	3.40	With this course leave mountain.
North	4.50	4 ft. above water at 2.50 chs.  leave dense undergrowth and enter cleared land.
S.53½°W	7.00	At 35 lks. cross mouth of Salander Creek; 15 lks. wide, course N and SW. Point of St. Patrick's rock, bears N.5°E.
N.73°W	3.60	
N.5°E	3.80	John Salander's house bears N.5°E. his barn, 15°E., 2.00 chs. dist.
N.42½°E	3.00	John Salander's house, bears W. At 1.00 ch. enter dense undergrowth.
North	2.20	To top of rocky ridge, 50 ft. above lake, and extending with perpendicular walls into lake, and known as St. Patrick's rock.
N.21½°E	2.60	Over rocky point, 50 ft. above lake. Descend.  Point of St. Patrick's rock, bears S.70°E.
N.55½°E	2.40 chs.	At 1.40 enter slashing covered with brush and logs.
