CHAINS

N.46½*W	6.30	At 6.15 a mouth of creek, 15 lks. wide, course from W. The meander cor. of frac. secs. 11 and 12, 13 and 14, bears N.85*05'E.
N.20½*E	2.00	To rocky side of mountain. At 1.20 cross another mouth of creek, 15 lks. wide, course NE and SW. Thence in deep undergrowth.
East	1.20	Along steep rocky side of mountain, 10 ft. above waters edge.
N.80*E	3.10	
N.30½*E	2.60	
N.53½*E	4.10	
N.24½*E	2.70	Leave mountainside and descend.
N.20½*W	3.00	To bottom land 4 ft. above water.
N.58*W	1.20	To alder tree marked as N.
N.67*W	0.92	Line of sec. 11 under contract No. 292.
N.26*W	2.10	To meander cor. of frac. secs. 2 and 11.

Land, mountainous, all but 16.40 chs. dense undergrowth.
The valley of Salander Creek is about 15 lks. wide, and
is a fertile loam mixed with stone.

Soil, mostly rocky; 3rd and 2nd rate.

But little timber.

Dense undergrowth, salal, vine maple and huckleberry.

Land, mountainous or covered with dense undergrowth,

from cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, bears S.49*30'E.

Meander cor. bet. secs. 1 and 2, bears N.27*18'E.
