| N.34*E | 4.70 | At 3.25 frame of house belonging to Geo. E. Shafer, known as Rocky Haven bears N.5*E. about 5.00 chs. dist. |
| N.60*E | 1.60 | |
| N.47*E | 2.00 | |
| N.37*E | 2.10 | At 1.25 W side of rock, 50 ft. sq. and 20 ft. high. |
| N.50*E | 0.90 | Over huge boulders. |
| S.87*E | 2.40 | At 0.25 a solid road runs N to Geo. E. Shafer's house. At 2.15, a bears den in rocks. |
