61.00	McKinley Creek, 40 ft. below top of spur, course S Ascend along right bank of creek
66.75	Leave McKinley Creek, course S
68.25	To bank of McKinley Creek 30 lks. wide, course SE Begin ascent
80.00	Set a pine post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 25, 36, 35, and 26, marked T 24 S S 25 on NE, R 1 W S 36 on SE, S 35 on SW and S 26 on NW faces, with 1 notch on S and E edges; from which <div style="margin-left: 40px;"> A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.18*E., 45 lks. dist. Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 35 B T A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.64*W., 66 lks. dist. Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 26 B T </div> This cor. is about 40 ft. above McKinley creek, on a spur, sloping W Land, mountainous Soil, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th rates Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, elder, maple, chin-capin, and madrona Dense undergrowth of rhododendron, vine-maple, mountain-balm, chin-capin, huckle-berry, hemlock, fir, and salal-berry.
