	Thence I run South, 89°52'W., on true line, bet. secs. 13 and 24 Descend
11.60	Creek, 4 lks. wide, course SE, 100 ft. below sec. cor. Begin ascent
39.80	Set a fir post, 3½ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. marked ¼ S on N face, bet. secs. 13 and 24, from which <div style="margin-left: 40px;">A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.82°E., 31 lks. dist. Marked ¼ S B T A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.23½°E., 32 lks. dist. Marked ¼ S B T</div> This cor. is on a steep hillside, sloping NE about 150 ft. above creek.
56.15	Top of spur, sloping SE about 75 ft. above ¼ sec. cor. Continue ascent
75.10	Top of ridge, bears N and S about 100 ft. above ¼ sec. cor. Descend
79.60	To cor. of secs. 13, 24, 23, and 14, about 75 ft. below top of ridge. Land, mountainous Soil, 3rd rate and 4th rate Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, chincapin, and madrone Dense undergrowth of vine-maple, rhododendron, mountain-balm, hazel, hemlock, huckleberry and cedar Mountainous land, or covered with dense undergrowth, 79.60 chs.
