A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.50°E., 73 lks. dist.

Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 1 B T

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.17°E., 90 lks. dist.

Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 12 B T

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.31°W., 14 lks. dist.

Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 11 B T

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.55°W., 39 lks. dist.

Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 2 B T

This cor. is on a steep hillside sloping W about 25 ft.  
below spur, last noted

Land, mountainous

Soil, 3rd rate

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, chincapin, madrona,  
maple, and yew

Dense undergrowth of rhododendron, vine-maple, chincapin,  
mountain-balm, huckleberry, hemlock, fir, pine, hazel,  
and salal-berry

Mountainous land or covered with dense undergrowth 80 chs.

and 12

Ascend

3.25 Spur, sloping SE about 25 ft. above sec. cor.

Begin descent

11.00 McKinley Creek, 6 lks. wide, course S.30°E., about 50 ft.

below spur last noted. Begin ascent
