CHAINS	
51.50	Top of ridge, bears NW and SE about 25 ft. above $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. Begin descent. Va. 24*E
53.50	Va. 27*E
61.55	creek, 1 lk. wide, course S.60*E., about 150 ft. below ridge.
65.75	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE. Begin ascent
67.51	Top of spur, sloping SE about 25 ft. above creek Begin descent
70.10	Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S.60*E., about 25 ft. below spur. Begin ascent
80.00	Set a chincapin post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 26, 35, 34, and 27, marked T 24 S S 26 on NE, R 1 W S 35 on SE, S 34 on SW, and S 27 on NW faces, with 1 notch on S and 2 notches on E edges; from which <div style="margin-left: 40px;">A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.38*E., 38 lks. dist. Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 35 B T</div> <div style="margin-left: 40px;">A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears S.62*W., 49 lks. dist. Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 34 B T</div> <div style="margin-left: 40px;">A fir, 42 ins. diam., bears N.41*W., 58 lks. dist. Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 27 B T</div> This cor. is on a steep hillside, sloping SW about 75 ft. above creek Land, mountainous Soil, 3rd and 4th rates Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, chincapin, yew, madrona and alder Dense undergrowth of rhododendron, vine-maple, chincapin, mountain balm, ocean-spray, hemlock, fir, cedar, salal-berry and huckleberry
