

Subdivisions of T. 24 S., R. 1 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.65*E., 65 lks. dist.

Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 23 B T

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 14 lks. dist.

Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 26 B T

A pine, 16 ins. diam., bears S.67*W., 58 lks. dist.

Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 27 B T

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.47*W., 81 lks. dist.

Marked T 24 S R 1 W S 22 B T

This cor. is on top of spur, sloping W about 25 ft. above creek, last noted.

Land, mountainous

Soil, 3rd and 4th rates

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, chincapin, maple, alder, madrona and yew

Dense undergrowth of rhododendron, vine-maple, mountain-balm, chincapin, huckle-berry, hemlock, fir, cedar, and salal-berry.

Mountainous land or covered with dense undergrowth 80.00 chs.

August 1, 1896

South 89*47'E on random line bet. secs. 23 and 26

40.00 Set a temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.15 Intersect N and S line 20 lks. S of cor. of secs. 24, 25, 26, and 23

Thence I run North, 89*56'W on true line, bet. secs. 23 and 26

Descend steep mountain side

16.19 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S.70*W., about 200 ft. below sec. cor.

37.15 Foot of descent, about 100 ft. below creek, last noted, bears SE and NW. Enter creek, 40 lks. wide course S.30*E

Pass through creek bottom

39.97 Leave creek bed, 40 lks. wide, course E
