CHAINS	
21.20	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S.60*W., about 250 ft. below sec. cor. Begin ascent
39.42	Top of spur, sloping SW about 25 ft. above creek Descend
40.05	Set a chincapin post, 3½ ft. long 3 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ S on N face, from which A cedar, 16 ins. diam., bears N.5*W., 55 lks. dist. Marked ¼ S B T A chincapin, 6 ins. diam., bears S.55*W., 15 lks. dist. Marked ¼ S B T This cor. is on a hillside, sloping W about 20 ft. below top of spur
57.60	Foot of descent. Enter creek bottom, about 125 ft. below ¼ sec. cor.
59.60	Creek, 30 lks. wide, course S.40*E
60.84	Leave creek bottom, and begin ascent, bears NW and SE
80.10	To cor. of secs. 14, 23, 22 and 15, about 375 ft. above creek bottom Land, mountainous Soil, 3rd and 4th rates Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, chincapin, yew, madrone and maple Dense undergrowth of rhododendron, vine-maple, chincapin, mountain-balm, hemlock, fir, cedar, and huckleberry Mountainous land, or covered with dense undergrowth 80.10 chs.
