	Soil, 3rd and 4th rates Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, chincapin, maple, and alder Dense undergrowth of rhododendron, vine-maple, chincapin, mountain-balm, hemlock, fir, huckle-berry, and salal-berry. Mountainous land or covered with dense undergrowth 79.90 chs.
	West on true line, bet. secs. 19 and 30 Mag. decl. 19*E Descent
5.06	A fir, 54 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on E and W sides
12.27	Spur sloping S.80*W., about 100 ft. below sec. cor. Mag. decl. 21*E
23.75	Creek, 10 lks. wide, course S.75*W., about 250 ft. below sec. cor. Begin ascent
37.25	Top of spur, sloping S., about 15 ft. above creek last noted. Descend
40.00	Set a basalt stone, 16x14x12 ins. 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N face, from which A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.52*E., 5 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.19*W., 40 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T This cor. is on a steep hillside, sloping W about 25 ft. below spur last noted
41.00	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S about 25 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Ascend
44.25	Spur, sloping S about 50 ft. above creek
59.75	Top of spur, sloping S about 250 ft. above spur, last noted. Descend
