Land, mountainous.

Soil, 3rd rate.

Densely covered with forest of pine, fir, cedar, maple,  
laurel & dogwood.

Thick undergrowth of vine maple, hazel, huckleberry &  
sallal.

A cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears N.50\*W. 44 lks. dist.  
marked T 24 S R 3 W S 24 B T.
