CHAINS

- 65.50 A brook, 2 lks. wide, course S.10*W.
- 79.52 Intersect the N. & S. line 61 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 3, 4, 9 & 10, which is a post firmly set in the ground 4 ins. sq., marked T 24 S S 3 on NE., R 3 W S 10 on SE., S 9 on SW. & S 4 on NW. faces with 5 notches on S. and and 3 notches on E. edges, from which
- A maple, 5 ins. diam., bears N.32*E. 25 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 3 W S 3 B T.
- A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.20*E. 8 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 3 W S 10 B T.
- A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears S.62*W. 9 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 3 W S 9 B T.
- A maple, 5 ins. diam., bears N.2*W. 26 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 3 W S 4 B T.
- Thence I run
- S.89*34'W. on true line bet. secs. 4 & 9, with same var.
- 39.76 Set chittim post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face, from which
- A dogwood, 8 ins. diam., bears N.10*E. 39 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears S.52*W. 76 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- 79.52 The cor. to secs. 4, 5, 8 & 9.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, 3rd rate.
- Densely covered with forests of red, white & yellow fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, laurel, chinquapin, yew & chittim.
- Thick undergrowth of sallal, vine maple, hazel, fir, manzanita thimble, huckle, salmon & elder berry & arrow wood.
