## Subdivisions of T. 24 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

Densely covered with forests of red, yellow & white fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, laurel, chinquapin, yew & chittim.

Thick undergrowth of sallal, vine maple, hazel, fir, manzanita, thimble, huckle, salmon & elder berry & arrow wood.

West, on random line between Secs. 7 & 18.

Var.  $21\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.

Through timber.

13.52 A fir, 20 ins. diam.

20.00 A ridge, course N.20\*W. & S.

Descend along N. side of spur.

32.17 A fir, 10 ins. diam.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

40.73 A fir, 30 ins. diam.

52.24 A cedar, 30 ins. diam.

79.07 Intersect the West bdy. of the Township 84 lks. N. of cor. to secs. 7, 12, 13 & 18, which is a post, 4 ins. sq., firmly set in the ground, marked T 24 S S 7 on NE., R 3 W S 18 on SE., R 4 W S 13 on SW., S 12 on NW. faces, with 2 notches on N. and 4 notches on S. edges, from which

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.20\*E. 33 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 3 W S 7 B T.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.61\*E. 8 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 3 W S 18 B T.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.29\*W. 33 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 4 W S 13 B T.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.72\*W. 45 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 4 W S 12 B T.

Thence I run

N.89\*24'E. on true line between secs. 7 & 18, with same var.
