Var. 18°35'E.

1.00 Top of hill and begin to descend.

10.00 Leave Oak Openings and enter Prairie course E.&W.

35.25 To a low bottom course N.E.&S.E. -800

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. post
Drove charred stake and raised mound with trench
and pits as per instructions.

45.81 S.31°E. to Alexander Cannuck's house about 20 chains.

71.75 To a pack trail course N,W.&S.E.

73.00 Enter low wet bottom N.30°W. & S.30°E.

79.00 Leave low wet bottom N.30°W. & S.30°E.

80;00 Set post cor. to Secs. 15,16,21 & 22. +40
Drove charred stake and raised mound with trench
and pits as per instructions.
South 10 chains Oak Openings on the North slope of a
very steep hill. Balance rolling prairie.
Soil, good 2nd rate.

East, on Random between Secs. 15 & 22.

Var. 18°30'E.

79.86 Intersect N.&S. line 27 lks. South of Sec. Cor.
S.89°49'W, on true line between Secs. 15 & 22.

24.00 Leave Oak Openings and enter prairie N.20°E. & S.20°W. -200

39.93 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. post. -20
Drove charred stake and raised mound with trench
and pits as per instructions.

56.61 To Pollock Creek 20 lks. wide course South. -75

79.86 To Section Corner. +50
East 24 chains Oak openings, balance Prairie all rolling
and hilly.
