50.30	Leave same, course NE.
50.38	Marked an Alder, 18 ins. diam., for meander post, right bank of Umpqua River, from which An Alder, 24 ins. diam., bears S.10*E., 35 lks. dist. A Maple, 36 ins. diam., bears West, 4 lks. dist. Offset S.66*E., 9.92 chs., whence an Ash, 6 ins. diam., on opposite bank in line bears N.38½*W., dist., 7.35 chs.
57.73	Marked same ash for meander post, left hand of river, from which A Myrtle, 15 ins. diam., bears N.40*E., 24 lks. dist. A Myrtle, 6 ins. diam., bears N.40*W., 5 lks. dist.
58.25	Trail, course E and W.
80.00	Set post, from which A Laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 8 lks. dist. A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.45*W., 25 lks. dist. Land hilly, timber fir, cedar, maple, myrtle and laurel. Soil 3rd rate. Land N., very steep and rocky.
West bet. secs. 11 and 14.	
2.00	Marked a Willow, 12 ins. diam., for meander post, right bank of Umpqua river, from which A Willow, 12 ins. diam., bears N.10*E., 5 lks. dist. A Willow, 12 ins. diam., bears S.5*E., 33 lks. dist From pt. in line on opposite bank, offset N.7*W., 150 lks. base, whence meander post on right bank bears S.72½*E., dist., 4.56.
7.00	Set meander post, left bank of river, from which An Alder, 6 ins. diam., bears N.86*W., 55 lks. dist. An Alder, 18 ins. diam., bears S.88*W., 69 lks. dist.
