

Subdivisions of T 24 S., R 7 W., W.M.

CHAINS		
	About $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile bottom, balance hilly, Timber, cedar, maple, myrtle and laurel. Soil 2nd rate.	
	North bet. secs. 2 and 3. Va. 19*10'E.	
6.50	Enter river bottom, course NW and SE.	-100
18.15	Intersect left bank of Umpqua and set meander post, from which A Myrtle, 18 ins. diam., bears S.65*W., 11 lks. dist. A Myrtle, 15 ins. diam., bears S.20*E., 15 lks. dist. Set flag, from Pt. in line on opposite bank, offset E., 194 lks. base, whence flag bears N.16*W., lat. 674 lks.	
24.89	Set meander post, right bank, from which A Maple, 36 ins. diam., bears N.70*W., 16 lks. dist. An Ash, 12 ins. diam., bears S.30*E., 34 lks. dist.	
25.75	Road, course NW and SE.	+20
38.70	Branch, 8 lks. wide, course SW.	+50
40.00	Set $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. post, from which. A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.60*W., 63 lks. dist. A Maple, 15 ins. diam., bears S.70*E., 45 lks. dist.	+20
62.25	Enter prairie, course NE and SW.	+500
75.65	Intersect S boundary, T 23 S R 7 W., 990 chs. W of cor. secs. 34, 35, 2 and 3. Set post, cor. secs. 2 and 3, from which a fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.45*E., 9 lks. dist. A Fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S.70*W., 4 lks. dist. This intersection was so far W of cor. that it was deemed better to establish the cor. at the point of intersection with S boundary of T 23 S., R 7 W. Land very rough and hilly except a narrow strip along the river and a few chains in N boundary.	+100
