50.97	Set meander post on left bank, from which An Alder, 24 ins. diam., bears N.62*W., 25 lks. dist. An Ash, 12 ins. diam., bears N.28*E., 15 lks. dist.	
52.75	Enter prairie, course NE and SW.	
55.50	Leave same, course NW and SE.	
55.60	Intersect a slough and set flag. From pt. in line on opposite bank, offset E., 70 lks. base, whence flag bears S.19*W., lat 205 lks.	
57.65	Over same, course E.	
75.00	Enter prairie, course NE and SW.	
80.00	Set post, cor. secs., from which An Oak, 12 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 170 lks. dist. An Oak, 12 ins. diam., bears N.50*E., 186 lks. dist. An Oak, 12 ins. diam., bears N.1*W., 645 lks. dist. An Oak, 24 ins. diam., bears S.5*W., 511 lks. dist. Land about the same as last mile.

2.00	Leave prairie and enter timber, course N and S.	-500
23.00	Trail, course N and S.	
26.20	Intersect left bank Umpqua river, from which An Alder, 10 ins. diam., bears N.62*W., 17 lks. dist. A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.25*W., 52 lks. dist. Offset N., 304 lks. base, whence a flag in line on right bank bears S.67*E., dep. 7.17.	-10
33.43	Marked a Fir, 10 ins. diam., for meander post, right bank from which A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 8 lks. dist. A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.30*E., 29 lks. dist. Land about the same as last mile. East of this meander post, land is very rough and moun- tainous, unfit for settlement.
