	A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.80*E., 28 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.
	A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.22*W., 18 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
45.50	Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, flows SE about 75 ft. below top of ridge, ascend about 150 ft. to
56.70	Top of ridge, course SE., descend about 100 ft. to
67.00	Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, flows E., ascend about 150 ft. to
79.80	Top of ridge, course NE.
80.00	Set post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, marked T 24 S S 6 on NE., R 7 W S 7 on SE., R 8 W S 12 on SW., and S 1 on NW faces, with 5 notches on S and 1 notch on N edges, from which A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.17*E., 64 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 7 W S 6 B T . A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.8*E., 107 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 7 W S 7 B T . A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.16*W., 59 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 8 W S 12 B T . A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.39*W., 78 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 8 W S 1 B T .
	Land rolling bench, on S., 2.00 chs.
	Land mountainous, 78.00 chs.
	Soil sandy and rocky, 2nd and 4th rate.
	Heavily timbered with fir and hemlock, 80.00 chs.
	Dense undergrowth of laurel, hazel and sallow, 80.00 chs.
	North on E boundary of sec. 1. Va. 20*E. Along side of ridge, sloping NE through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
