And secs. South of the cor.
 At point of intersection I set a post, 4½ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to T. 24 S., Rs. 7 & 8 W., marked
 C C T 24 S on S.,
 R 7 W S 6 on E., and
 R 8 W S 1 on W faces with 6 notches on S, E & W faces, from which,
 A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.57°E., 83 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 7 W S 1 B T.
 A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.57°E., 120 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 8 W S 1 B T.
 A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.38°W., 85 lks. dist. marked T 24 S Rs. 7 & 8 B T.
 Land, mountainous 81.75 chs.
 Soil, 2nd. and 4th rate.
 Heavily timbered with fir & hemlock, 81.75 chs.
 Dense undergrowth of laurel, small fir and sallal, 81.75 chs.

 A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.37°E., 113 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 7 W S 33 B T.
 A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.48°E., 135 lks. dist. marked T 25 S R 7 W S 4 B T.
 A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.60°W., 29 lks. dist. marked T 25 S R 7 W S 5 B T.
 A laurel, 24 ins. diam., bears N.35°W., 63 lks. dist.
