	Thence I run.
	West on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 36.
	Va. 20*35'E.
	Descend through timber.
29.90	A stream, 3 lks. wide, course S.60*E., a point about 650 ft. below Tp. cor. and ascend.
35.20	Top of a ridge, course south, about 100 ft. above stream and descend.
40.00	Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N face, from which A Maple, 14 ins. diam., bears S.9*W., 33 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.47*E., 33 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S E T.
60.35	A stream, 2 lks. wide, course S.20*W.
80.00	A point about 600 ft. below top of last ridge and set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, marked T 24 S S 36 on NE., T 25 S S 1 on SE., R 7 W S 2 on SW and S 35 on NW faces with 1 notch on E and 5 notches on W edges, from which, A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.16 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 60 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 7 W S 36 B T. A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.61*E., 114 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 7 W S 1 B T. A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.17*W., 124 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 7 W S 2 B T. A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.50*W., 103 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 7 W S 35 B T.
	Land mountainous and broken, 80.00 chs.
	Soil 3rd and 4th rate.
	Heavily timbered with fir, cedar, hemlock and alder, some of it burnt and fallen, with dense undergrowth of hazel thimbleberry and briars, 80.00 chs.
