

Exterior Boundaries of T 24 S., R 7 W., W.M.

CHAINS

October 27, 1893

West on a true line bet. secs. 34 and 3.

Va. 20\*35'E.

Descend through timber.

- 2.70 A stream, 2 lks. wide, course NE., and ascend.
- 14.70 Top of a ridge, about 550 ft. high, course N.20\*W., and descend.
- 38.70 A stream, 3 lks. wide, course N.25\*W., a point about 500 ft. below top of ridge, and ascend.
- 40.00 Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on N face, from which  
     A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.82\*E., 38 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.  
     A Yew, 6 ins. diam., bears N.32 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*W., 70 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- 67.70 Summit of mountain, course N.20\*W., about 900 high and descend gradually to
- 80.00 Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 3, 4, T 25 S R 7 W., marked T 25 S R 7 W on S., S 3 on E and S 4 on W., with 3 notches E and W faces, from which  
     A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.66\*E., 19 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 7 W S 3 B T.  
     A Cedar, 18 ins. diam., bears S.65\*W., 19 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 7 W S 4 B T.  
     A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.43\*E., 22 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 7 W S 3 and 4 B T.
- I marked but three bearing trees at this cor., having previously ascertained that the cor. to secs. 33 and 34 would be a closing cor., 3.14 chs. east of this point.
- Land mountainous, 80.00 chs.
- Soil 3rd rate.
- Heavily timbered with fir, cedar and maple, with a dense undergrowth of hazel, thimbleberry, sallow and briars, 80.00 chs.
